1. Theme: "IPM on the World Stage"
2. Decide upon a tag-line. "IPM Solutions for Global Pest Challenges"
3. Review and finalize the main session topics. The three topics seem appropriate: Management, Outreach, and Best Practices (without the word "tools."). Each topic will include evaluation. Naresh will provide brief annotation to explain the topics.
4. Refine session subtopics. Mark will organize a session on biological control communication or outreach. We may have a session on bio-communication to include biosecurity due to societal concerns. Each formal session topic must have a designated organizer. Add a session on educating the next generation of IPM practitioners. Naresh will provide brief annotation to explain the topic major and minor categories proposed and confirm the table below has been updated correctly. There are 12 large breakout rooms in Memphis.
5. Decide on the venue for a reception on Monday night. Have the reception at the RockNSoul Museum. The RockNSoul Museum is about 1 mile from the Convention Center and there is a trolley. Do not have a speaker. The museum will be closed except for our group. Set-up food at various locations to encourage mixing. Have guided tours if available. Publicize the event early and encourage attendance. Monday night may not be such a travel problem in Memphis as it was in Portland. Allow more time for the event than at Portland. The museum can handle 400 people.
6. The next Program Committee conference call. The call will be on June 4th at 2:30 pm EST. Agenda topics will be planning for the call for sessions. We will develop a matrix of sessions similar to the process used for Portland. We also will consider brainstorming session topics.
