Poster abstracts should be submitted online at <https://ipmsymposium.org/2022/posters.html> by November 12, 2021 for full consideration. The abstract must contain an accurate summary of the work and be clear and concise. Instructions for abstract submissions can be found on the Poster web site.

Posters will be organized by division: Communication and Program Analysis; Forestry/Natural Landscapes/Turf & Sod/Rangeland/Livestock/Pastures; Horticulture Crops (Vegetables, Fruits, Nuts); Infographics; Overarching/Cross-Disciplinary; Row/Field Crops (Soybean, Corn, Canola, Pulses, Cereals, Industrial Hemp, etc.); Specialty Crops (Nursery, Greenhouse, Hydroponic, Ornamental); Urban/Structural/Landscape/School IPM/Public Health/Veterinary.

New this year is a category for infographic posters. An infographic is a collection of imagery, charts, and minimal text that gives an easy-to-understand overview of a topic. Infographics use striking, engaging visuals to communicate information quickly and clearly.

Students are encouraged to submit poster abstracts of their work to be entered into the Student IPM Inspiration Award competition.
